1. Meeting Called to Order

2. Welcome and self-introductions

4. Approval of Minutes

a) Long Term Pool Agreement - The Treasurer has had discussions regarding a Long Term Pool Agreement with the Children & Family Commission, John Wayne Airport, and Integrated Waste Management Department (IWMD). A draft

agreement is in circulation for approval by the Treasurer's office and County Counsel.

- **b)** Local Investment Pools Some county agencies are voluntarily participating in a LGIP survey. This survey should be finished in 3 months. California and the state of Washington are the only states that have local county pools, so this information will be a useful management tool.
- c) Legislative Update SB268 is moving right along. It has already been approved in the State Senate and the next action will occur in the State Assembly.
- **d) SB866 Audit Update** The first draft will be available on May 10, 2005. The Treasurer's Office will make copies available to the TOC members before the next meeting on July 27, 2005.

7. Proposed Changes to the Investment Policy Statement (IPS)

There were handouts given to the TOC members regarding the four items brought forth to review for changes on the 2006 Investment Policy Statement (IPS). There was a brief discussion on each item. The items are the following:

- 1) Credit Watch Negative Language;
- 2) Issuer Limit-25% for three days (conforming with SB 268);
- 3) Merrill Lynch technical clean-up; and
- 4) Technical clean-up on the ethics and conflict of interest paragraph regarding "designated employees."

Mr. Fauteux called for a <u>motion</u> to receive and file the proposals. Mr. Habermehl <u>moved</u> to receive and file. <u>2nd</u> by Mr. Beckett. <u>Passed</u> 4-0.
